At First Church's Two Hundred Fifty-eighth Annual Meeting, in celebration of the almost 30 years that First Church has been serving meals at Loaves and Fishes, we were treated to a luncheon prepared by Church Council members which featured two casseroles that many volunteers have faithfully prepared for Loaves and Fishes over these three decades.

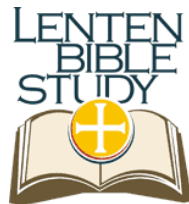
